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- Brief Organization Profile

Since inception to some years between 1974 and 1978 a young team under the leadership of Mr. Akshay Kumar Chakraborty , Mr. Subhas Chandra pal and a few young group continued small social service activities through local resource mobilization

~~and a small financial support from Mandra Unnayan Sansad with active support help and co operation of Mr. Hararam Singha Roy president of the same organization~~

In 1979 The organization was Registered under West Bengal Society Registration Act. After gaining a legal status organization had worked for the deprived , vulnerable and excluded and unprivileged children , families and communities. The activities included for community development, road development, small infrastructure development and health and education services. Along with organization developed an Agro Service Centre through peoples organization and also strengthen three youth club and two Mahila Mondal by organization itself and from Neheru Yuva Kendra.

The organization was fortunate to have contact and got affiliation from Christian Children Fund (presently known as Child Fund International) in 1986 for working extensively in local communities. initially ten village covered and as major fund flow included more number of village nearby.

The core objective was integrated and all round development of children and integrated rural development and economic self reliant of backward families in the community .

The project named child welfare project started in 1986 and continued till 2005 besides help and support from Child Fund , Organization implemented Govt. project (both central and state govt. on Soil Testing , child labour and awareness generation program. Organization has been working 48 years,

With a very small beginning flourished gradually. The organization still engages in the serving of children , families and community being carried out with supported of Asha USA besides

engaged in social development, the organization is a residential training centre of ASHA worker and ANMs.
